Planning Board

This is a seven member board & members can be appointed for up to three consecutive terms. Services & responsibilities of the Board include assistance in the development & administration of the Cascade County Development Plan that includes comprehensive planning and the permitting system. The board advises the County Commission on all land use matters and develops and administers Subdivision and Floodplain regulations. The board usually meets every third Tuesday of each month.

Zoning Board of Adjustments

(3 Openings, 2 year term)
(Term Expiration: December 31, 2018)

Pursuant to [76-2-223, MCA](#), zoning boards of adjustment have the exclusive power and authority to independently hear and decide zoning appeals and applications for zoning variances and special exceptions. The five-member Board of Adjustments meets on an as-needed basis with members serving without compensation. Board members serve two staggered terms.

Cascade County Weed Board

(3 openings, 2 year term)

This is a five member board appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. The members appointed to the Board represent North, South, West, and East portions of the County as well as a representative from within the City.

The Board assists in developing criteria for noxious weeds on land within the County. The Board cooperates with citizens, corporations, and federal and state governments in a noxious weed abatement program.

City-County Health Board (1 Vacancy, 3 year term) (Term Expiration: December 31, 2019)

The Board of County Commissioners has one vacancy to fill on the City-County Health Board. The appointed citizen will serve three (3) years with a term expiration date of December 31, 2019. The Board meets the first Wednesday (11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.) each month in the City-County Health Department Conference room.

The Board consists of seven members:

- One Cascade County Commissioner to be appointed by the County Commissioners.
- The Mayor of the City of Great Falls or a representative.
- The Superintendent of School District #1 or a representative.
- One licensed doctor of medicine residing in Cascade County.
- One licensed doctor of dentistry residing in Cascade County.
- One interested citizen appointed by the City of Great Falls Commission.
- One interested citizen appointed by the Cascade County Commission.

The Board of Health is primarily responsible for the management and oversight of the public health systems as administered by the City-County Health Department (CCHD).

Key responsibilities of the Board of Health members include the following:

- Appointing and fixing the salary of the local Health Officer.
- Attending regular monthly board meetings.
- Protecting the public from the introduction and spread of communicable diseases.
- Directing actions to track, identify, screen, inspect, and abate public health issues.
- Take actions and issue orders to abate, restrain, or prosecute violations of public health issues.
- Establish local sanitation standards for sewage disposal.
- Accept and spend funds received to support public health activities.
- Adopt local regulations to support compliance with Montana public health laws established in MCA 50-2.
- Provide, implement, facilitate, and encourage other public health services and functions.

Board of Health members perform a critical role in local public health matters. They provide strategic guidance and oversight across all programs delivered by CCHD and insures that responsibilities established under Montana public health laws are complied with.
