DISASTER DECLARATION - FLOODING
CASCADE COUNTY, MONTANA

RESOLUTION NO. 18-60

WHEREAS, beginning on June 18, 2018 Cascade County experienced severe flooding that threatened the lives and property of residents and caused widespread damage to public and private property, and,

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners declared a state of emergency as established in Resolution No. 18-58, R0357201, in accordance with MCA sec. 10-3-402, and

WHEREAS, floodwaters have now receded and the County has committed all available resources and taken all possible action to recover from the flood but local resources are not adequate to repair the extensive damage to public infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that pursuant to MCA sec. 10-3-402(3) the state of emergency declared on June 20, 2018 as Resolution 18-58, R0357201, is hereby rescinded and a disaster is hereby declared for Cascade County pursuant to MCA sec. 10-3-403, because expenditures for repair will be beyond the financial capability of the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Disaster Declaration Resolution will be filed with the Cascade County Clerk and Recorder and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena.
