Meeting-Brian Clifton called the meeting to order at 1:00 p. m.



Contents of Bid Package – Brian Clifton examined the contents of the bid packet and stated that a completed bid bond, Addendum #1, Bid Form, Bid Schedule, were included. The amount of the bid was \$788,189.90. See (exhibit “B”) for a copy of the Bid Schedule. He then announced that the bid packet was complete and will be taken under advisement.

INVITATION TO BID

Separate sealed bids for construction of Flood Road Surfacing Repairs will be received by Cascade County Commission Office at 325 2nd Avenue N, Rm 111, Great Falls Montana until 1:00 p.m. local time on May 14, 2015 and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of: Plant mix overlay and chip sealing of 1.8 miles of Flood Road and crack and chip sealing of 5.7 miles of Flood Road and Woodland Estate Road.

The contract documents consisting of Drawings and Project Manual may be examined or obtained at the office of TDH Engineering – 1800 River Drive North, Great Falls Montana accordance with Article 2.01 of Instructions To Bidders. A deposit of \$50 per set is required.

There will be a **Pre-Bid Conference** at the office of Cascade County Public Works, 279 Vaughn South Frontage Road at 9:00 AM on May 6, 2015. Interested CONTRACTORS are encouraged to attend.

CONTRACTORS and any of the CONTRACTORS' subcontractors bidding or doing work on this project will be required to be registered with the Montana Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). Information on registration can be obtained by calling 1-406-444-7734. All laborers and mechanics employed by CONTRACTOR or subcontractors in performance of the construction work shall be paid wages at rates as may be required by the laws of the State of Montana.




