AGREEMENT FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF NOXIOUS WEEDS
ON THE COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY

I/We, _____, do hereby request permission to manage noxious weeds along the following described county right-of-way bordering or running through our property.

AGREEMENT

I.

The Permittee agrees to place signs, along the right-of-way boundary, on each side of the highway at the beginning and end of the management area. The signs shall be at least 18 inches by 18 inches square with a bright yellow or white background and two (2) diagonal red lines, approximately one (1) inch wide, extending from corner to corner to form an **X**.

II.

The Permittee agrees to submit annually a management plan to the Noxious Weed Management office for approval by the Weed Board outlining the management techniques to be used.

III.

The parties hereto expressly understand the Permittee is not an employee or agent of Cascade County Noxious Weed Management District in any sense, but is solely an independent contractor.

IV.

Permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Cascade County and the County Noxious Weed Management District from any and all liability that may be incurred due to the Permittee's actions under this contract.

If the Weed Board finds that the Permittee has failed to adhere to the agreement, the Board shall issue an order informing the Permittee that the agreement will be void and the responsibility for the management of noxious weeds on the right-of-way will revert to the Board, unless the Permittee complies with the management plan within a specified time period. (7-22-2153, M.C.A.)
