Resolution 23-29: Prosecutorial Assistance from the Office of the Montana State Auditor, Commissioner of Securities and Insurance, in the prosecution of *State of Montana vs. P.D.L.*

Resolution 23-30: Modification of Resolution 23-01 to Incorporate Public Comment per MCA § 2-3-103 to Cascade County Commission Work Session Agendas. (Ref: Resolution 23-01, R0439797)

Contract 23-82: 310 Permit CA-18-23AP - Ronald Brinkman/Sun River. Application is for a temporary L shaped aluminum dock where the previous owner had a dock on the Sun River.

Contract 23-83: Noxious Weed Control Agreement Between Montana Department of Transportation and Cascade County. Purpose: The purpose of this agreement is to set forth the terms and conditions for the control of listed noxious weeds within the limits of the rights-of-way on all state routes within Cascade County Weed District, for state routes which are under the jurisdiction of MDT. MDT to Pay: \$57,000/annual.

Contract 23-84: MT DPHHS HEART Grant Contract 23-102-74012-0 Amendment #1 for Detention Services. This amendment will allow for bi-weekly funding of the current Mental Health Provider and to fund an additional full-time Care Coordinator position. Effective: July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2024. Total Amount: \$262,478.79 (Ref: Contract 22-193, R0439931)

Contract 23-85: Emergent 3 (E3) Service Agreement with the Cascade County Sheriff's Office. As part of the CCSO's School Safety Program initiative, Emergent 3 will offer real-time communication through installed desktop and mobile devices to help the CCSO reduce response time and increase reaction time during any emergency or crisis involving the enrolled rural Cascade County Schools. Effective: July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024. Cost: \$3000.00 Onboarding & Setup One-Time Fee + \$5000.00/year for three years. Total for this Term: \$8000.00

Contract 23-88: Ratification of Subrecipient Agreement between Cascade County and Sand Coulee Water District regarding the use of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for Water and/or Sewer Infrastructure Project. Total Award of ARPA Funds: \$13,409.14 Effective: Date of Signing - December 31, 2026.
