#### **PREMIUMS**

#### ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Entry office will process judging results as quickly as possible after completion of judging. Please allow 3 to 5 days. Notice will be posted in departments when premium checks are processed and ready in the Entry Office. The Entry Office will be open from July 30<sup>th</sup> through August 7<sup>th</sup> (8am to 6pm) and August 8<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> (9am to 4pm). Every effort should be made to collect your Premium Checks between these times. Premium Checks in the amount of \$399.99 or less may be cashed during these times in the Entry Office.

All remaining Premium Checks will be mailed to you in the name and at the address provided by you on the entry form. The Montana State Fair will only mail premium awards.

#### NOTE: A W9 must be filled out each year if either of the following apply to you:

- You have had changes to your name or address
- You are a first-time exhibitor at the Montana State Fair

#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. All participants at Montana State Fair events are responsible for reading the Montana State Fair GENERAL INFORMATION Section and complying with policies listed therein. This section is located at goexpopark.com under the Montana State Fair tab.
- 2. AGREEMENT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS HEREIN STATED IS UNDERSTOOD WHEN THE EXHIBITOR SUBMITS THE ENTRY FORM.
- 3. All entrants must complete a W9 form at time of entry to receive any premiums.
- 4. **All exhibitors may purchase admittance tickets.** Adult and Youth exhibitors may purchase an Exhibitor's Packet for \$20 good for 10 admissions for Fair week. With purchase of first Exhibitor's Packet, additional free passes are issued for every \$50.00 of entry fees. Exhibitors may purchase individual tickets for \$4.00 each.
- 5. State Fair will accept exhibits not pre-entered, but exhibitors are warned that it will take longer for check-in. Exhibitors that submit entry forms prior to exhibit delivery day will be placed in an Express Line to speed up check in process.
- 6. \*ARTICLES ENTERED IN THIS DEPARTMENT MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN THE LAST TWO YEARS. ALL ARTICLES PREVIOUSLY EXHIBITED AT STATE FAIR WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 7. <u>ITEMS IN THIS DEPARTMENT MUST BE COMPLETELY OR PREDOMINANTLY CONSTRUCTED OF TEXTILES (SEE #11 OF EXHIBITOR TIPS). NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE PERMITTED.</u>
- 8. No live plants may be entered with articles nor will articles made of food be accepted.
- 9. ARTICLES ENTERED MAY NOT BE PICKED UP BEFORE THE STATED RELEASE TIME. See schedule.
- 10. At the superintendent's discretion, items entered may be transferred to a more appropriate class prior to judging.
- 11. When there is competition, articles may be awarded first, second, third or no premium, according to the merits of the article. No premium will be awarded when the article is unworthy, even if there is no competition.
- 12. No best of show prizes will be awarded if there are no items worthy of a special award.
- 13. No premiums will be allowed on articles purchased, received as gifts or borrowed.
- 14. Honorable mention ribbons will be awarded for meritorious work deserving of recognition, but no cash will be given for any award other than those listed in this premium book.
- 15. \*EXHIBITORS MAY ENTER NO MORE THAN TWO ITEMS PER CLASS.
- 16. \*Exhibitors are limited to entering items in ONE DIVISION ONLY (i.e. Open Class, Golden Age, Special Needs Exhibitor, or Youth).
- 17. Contest Entries are separate from Division entries and will not be judged in both categories.
- 18. Every article entered must be entirely the work of the exhibitor and be made of a textile. The following applies to quilts: Quilts entered that are NOT quilted by the exhibitor will be accepted because the quilting is not figured into the judging. Please state on paperwork if the quilting is done by another person.
- 19. Articles used prior to fair time must be clean and exhibit ready. State Fair reserves the right to reject articles deemed unsuitable for exhibition.
- 20. \*Judges may not enter work in category they are judging.

#### **EXHIBITOR TIPS!**

- 1. Knit and crocheted articles MUST BE BLOCKED and show ready.
- 2. Needlework will be judged with regard to beauty, degree of perfection, amount of work and suitability for the purpose for which it is intended.
- 3. Pictures framed must be evenly stretched with a neatly finished back. These need not be professionally done.
- 4. All wall hangings and pictures must be ready to hang. If rod is used, please include it with entry.
- 5. Excellence in sewing is determined in part by width and evenness in size of seams, hems, tacks, bands and gathers. Stitches should be fastened, basting removed, and everything neatly finished. In appearance, the work should be neat, clean and pressed with the material suitable for garment in which it is used.
- 6. If garment appears to be out of proportion, please include a picture of the garment being worn. This will aid the judges and insure fairness of their determinations.
- 7. Pillow stuffing and/or forms must fill out the corners of the fabric.
- 8. Rugs should be neatly finished. Latch hook rugs should have raw edges worked into the back of the design.
- 9. Linens should be blocked and starched as appropriate.
- 10. Due to space constraints, accessories for items to be exhibited will be accepted by superintendent permission only.
- 11. Textile: A flexible material comprised of a network of natural or artificial fibers referred to as thread or yarn. Textiles are formed by weaving, knitting, crocheting, knotting or pressing fibers together.
