PREMIUMS

You must fill out and return a current W-9 form in order to receive your premium check.

The Entry office will process judging results as quickly as possible after judging completion. Please allow 3 to 5 days. Notice will be posted in departments when premium checks are processed and ready in the Entry Office. The **Entry Office** will be open from **July 30th through August 7th (8am to 6pm) and August 8th through 12th (9am to 4pm)**. Every effort should be made to collect your Premium Checks between these times. Premium Checks in the amount of \$399.99 or less may be cashed during that time period in the Entry Office.

All remaining Premium Checks will be mailed to you in the name and at the address provided by you on the W-9. The Montana State Fair will only mail premium awards.

Each exhibitor must purchase one EXHIBITOR'S PACKET (\$20). Additional free passes will be issued for every \$50.00 of entry money sent in. Jr Livestock and open entries will be a combined total to qualify for additional passes.

Exhibitors must pay the \$10 office fee for each department entered (Open Beef & Jr. Livestock are two separate departments).

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All participants at Montana State Fair events are responsible for reading the Montana State Fair GENERAL INFORMATION Section and complying with policies listed therein. This section is located at cascadecountymt.gov under the Montana State Fair tab.
2. AGREEMENT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS HEREIN STATED IS UNDERSTOOD WHEN THE EXHIBITOR SUBMITS THE ENTRY FORM.
3. **ALL ENTRANTS MUST COMPLETE A W9 FORM AT TIME OF ENTRY TO RECEIVE ANY PREMIUMS.**
4. **Each exhibitor must purchase ONE EXHIBITOR'S PACKET (\$20).** Exhibitors will receive an additional free pass/packet for every \$50.00 of entry money sent in. Junior Livestock Department entries and Open and Junior Beef Department entries for an individual exhibitor will be a combined total to qualify for additional packets.
5. **Exhibitor's must pay the \$10 office fee for each department entered** (Open Beef is one department & Junior Livestock is another department).
6. **ENTRY DEADLINE: JULY 15th.** No entry will be considered complete unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fees. Late entries are subject to double entry fees on a space available basis. **NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER JULY 20th.**
7. Animals shown in all group classes must have been entered and shown in their respective individual classes. Premiums will be paid for group classes provided there is competition.
8. Champion exhibitors may be required to make publicity appearances. Cooperation is expected.
9. All cattle will be health and brand inspected.
10. Cattle will be stalled in the Livestock Pavilion on shavings. First bedding will be provided. Additional bedding will be available for purchase. Straw will only be allowed in tie-out area. Tie-outs are on the west side of the Livestock Pavilion.
11. **Cattle are required to be stalled in the Livestock Pavilion from 9:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day until release.**
12. No fees are charged for fitting chutes, but this privilege is allowed in designated areas only. Fitting chutes will not be allowed in the alleys.
13. All cattle must be halter broke and manageable.
14. **Neck ropes are required on all cattle.** Nose rings are required on bulls, except suckling bull calves.
15. Show numbers will be assigned per head and exhibitors are required to wear the assigned number at all times the individual animal is being judged.
16. All animals must be registered on the records of the various breed associations of classes listed herein. Original registration papers must be provided. Legible tattoos are required. Applicable Breed Association Rules and Regulations shall govern if not addressed herein.
17. Mothers of un-weaned 2021 calves will be allowed in the barn even if the cow is not entered, space permitting. Write "pen or stall needed for nurse cow" on entry form.
18. All applicable rules of the respective Breed Associations will be enforced.

ATTENTION! All cattle will need a Veterinary Health Inspection Certificate issued within 30 days of exhibit. Certificate must accompany animal upon arrival and be available for the duration of the exhibit.

****An office fee of \$10 per exhibitor will be charged****

SHOW DEFINITIONS:

OPEN SHOWS: Breed shows are offered for Angus, Shorthorn and Simmental cattle. If less than 20 head and three separate exhibitors per breed are shown in 2021, that breed may not be offered at the 2022 Montana State Fair.

ANY OTHER BREED SHOWS: Breed shows can be added for any recognized breed when a minimum of 20 head are entered by three or more independent exhibitors. If competition warrants, AOB shows may be split into more than one division at the discretion of management.

All entrants must check in with the Open Beef Secretary in the Entry Office in order to receive their exhibitor's numbers and passes. This must be done by Thursday morning!!

REGULATIONS: All general rules apply.

1. This show will abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the American Angus Association. Animals will be shown within the official standard show classifications of the American Angus Association.
2. All animals must be registered in the herd book of the American Angus Association. The registration certificate issue date must be prior to the show. Registration papers must be available for inspection.
3. All animals must have a legible ear tattoo for identification. The tattoo must correspond with the official registration certificate. Once disqualified due to incorrect or illegible tattoo, animals cannot be re-tattooed and rechecked at the show.
4. Any female shown with a calf at side, the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered.
