



## Cascade County COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility

	Pfizer-BioNTech	Moderna	Janssen/Johnson & Johnson
Eligibility for <b>primary dose series</b>	<b>Age 5 and older</b> receive a 2-dose primary series, separated by at least <b>21 days</b> .	<b>Age 18 and older</b> receive a 2-dose primary series, separated by at least <b>28 days</b> .	Age <b>18 and older</b> receive 1 primary dose.
Eligibility for <b>3<sup>rd</sup> primary dose for the immune compromised</b>	<p>If the first 2 doses were Pfizer or Moderna, then a 3<sup>rd</sup> dose may be given, not less than <b>28 days</b> after the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, to certain persons with <b>compromised immune systems</b>. A third dose of Pfizer may be given to eligible persons <b>age 5 and older</b>, and a third dose of Moderna may be given to eligible persons <b>age 18 and older</b>. If you are not sure whether you qualify as immune-compromised, please discuss with your physician.</p> <p><i>This is a 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of the primary vaccine series, not a booster; persons eligible for this 3<sup>rd</sup> primary dose may still receive a booster (4 doses in total) when eligible. Mixing-and-matching a different vaccine is not authorized for this 3<sup>rd</sup> primary dose.</i></p>		Not applicable
Eligibility for a <b>booster dose</b>	<p>If your first 2 (or 3) primary doses were Pfizer and you are <b>age 12 or older</b>, then you may receive a booster dose not less than <b>5 months</b> after your last primary Pfizer dose.</p> <p>If you are <b>age 18+</b>, your booster may be Pfizer, Moderna, or Janssen. If you are <b>age 12-17</b>, only the Pfizer booster is authorized. No boosters are authorized for people under the age of 12.</p>	<p>If your first 2 (or 3) primary doses were Moderna and you are <b>age 18 or older</b>, then you may receive a booster dose not less than <b>6 months</b> after your last primary Moderna dose. Your booster may be Pfizer, Moderna, or Janssen.</p>	<p>If your first dose was Janssen and you are <b>age 18 or older</b>, then you may receive a booster dose not less than <b>2 months</b> after the first dose. Your booster may be Pfizer, Moderna, or Janssen.</p>
Dose volume and formulation	<p>A booster or 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of Pfizer is a <b>full dose</b>. This applies regardless of which vaccine you received for your primary dose(s).</p> <p>Pfizer immunizations for age 5-11 are different in formulation, dose volume, and dilution from the immunizations for age 12+. Healthcare providers should carefully review the most recent Emergency Use Authorization and Provider Fact Sheet to ensure they are providing the correct formulation and dose.</p>	<p>A 3<sup>rd</sup> primary dose of Moderna for the <b>immune compromised</b> is a <b>full dose</b>.</p> <p>A booster dose of Moderna is a <b>half dose</b>. This applies regardless of which vaccine you received for your primary dose(s).</p>	<p>A booster dose of Janssen is a <b>full dose</b>. This applies regardless of which vaccine you received for your primary dose(s).</p>
