
In 2021, this office conducted 9 investigations into alleged PREA incidents. In summary; we had (3) alleged allegations of inmate-on-inmate non-consensual sexual acts (1) was substantiated, (2) were unsubstantiated, (0) were unfounded, (0) were ongoing investigations. We investigated (2) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate abusive sexual contact (0) was substantiated, (1) was unsubstantiated, (1) was unfounded. We investigated (1) alleged inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment incidents (0) was substantiated, (1) was unsubstantiated. We investigated (1) alleged staff sexual misconduct (0) substantiated, (1) unsubstantiated, (0) unfounded. We had (2) allegations of staff sexual harassment reported. (0) was substantiated, (2) was unsubstantiated.


In 2022, this office conducted 17 investigations into alleged PREA incidents. In summary; we had (0) alleged allegations of inmate-on-inmate non-consensual sexual acts We investigated (2) alleged incidents of inmate-on-inmate abusive sexual contact (1) was substantiated, (1) was unsubstantiated. We investigated (9) alleged inmate-on-inmate sexual harassment incidents. (0) were substantiated, (5) was unsubstantiated, (0) were unfounded, (4) were ongoing investigations. We investigated (6) alleged staff sexual misconduct (0) substantiated, (4) unsubstantiated, (2) unfounded. We had (0) allegation of staff sexual harassment reports.

The SART team did not have any recommendations in the following area's; (1) there **is no** need for policy changes at this time, (2) are the incidents motivated by race; ethnicity; gender identity; etc., **no**, (3) the investigator is the only one checking the area of the alleged incident, **no (primary patrol deputy and detention officers are assisting in primary preservation of evidence due to being first on scene)** (4) staffing levels are adequate for the size of our facility, **no (the CCSO/CCDC are handling the ongoing issue of jail overcrowding and overall short staff of detention officers to the best that we can on a daily basis with no relief insight)** (5) camera system is still a vital part of our investigative process, **yes**. PREA Investigator continues to do a great job in the office and at the JDC. Training for all employees, contractors, volunteers and inmates concerning PREA are on-going.
